Lexington unveils Grand Bahama from Tommy Bahama Home *Where the Sun Never Sets on Style*

Grand Bahama is a study in the art of layering. Meticulously crafted from quartered hickory, the collection is anchored by a golden chestnut finish, setting the stage for natural materials and textures that speak to the hands as much as the eye, including leather-wrapped rattan, pencil rattan, raffia, woven cane, and braided Lampakanai. Decorative accents showcase a stylized bamboo motif, while custom hardware in a rich bronze patina adds depth and sophistication to the assortment.



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Upholstery designs in **Grand Bahama** feature soft contemporary silhouettes with luxurious seating, highlighted by three fresh color palettes. The first is a biophilic correlation of textural chenilles in olive green, soft ivory and gold. The second brings warmth through cognac tones, tea-stained ikats and inviting bouclé textures. The third is a coastal composition of seaglass blues and eucalyptus shades anchored by pops of ivory and palm-inspired embroideries.
